Letter from Roger Preston, Administrator of St Mary's Parish

Rev. David Lloyd has now retired after giving 21 years of faithful service to the villages around here. The task of replacing him with a suitable person further to develop the spiritual aspects of village life is huge; as the congregations of the 5 churches within the Parish come together for this, they are seeking the help of the people of the Parish.

To this end, each church is organising a public meeting to explore how the population see this next stage unfolding – not only 'what are our spiritual needs?' but also the wider aspects of village life such as baby and toddler groups, the church schools, youth and elderly provision, etc. where should our priorities lie?

This will be on **Sunday 5th Nov 2017 in St Mary's Church at 11.45am** (following our 10.30am morning Holy Communion Service). Tea and biscuits will be provided and the meeting which will last about an hour, will be opened by our PCC chair, Dennis Piper. I as churchwarden, will give a short introduction to the recruitment timescale and the main component of the meeting – our future needs, will be led by local resident and Associate Priest at Bampton, the Revd. Dr Tess Kuin-Lawton."

In many respects, our RC friends are very interested parties in this process and we would welcome any input that they can offer then and in the future months as we progress along this journey.
