***Morning and Evening Prayer** Over the last couple of years we have been integrating morning prayer into morning Mass. The Vatican II document on liturgy states (Sacrosanctum Concilium, 84): "By tradition...the divine office is devised so that the whole course of the day and night is made holy for the praise of God. Therefore when...performed...by the faithful praying together with the priest...then it is truly the voice of the bride addressed to the bridegroom; it is the very prayer which Christ himself together with his body [the Church] addresses to the Father."
